



## Scoreboard Board Help

<b>Overview</b>	This role is responsible for accurately keeping score of the game in accordance with the Time Keepers score tally.
<b>Equipment</b>	Scoreboard
<b>Timing</b>	At Match commencement to the completion of the Match.
<b>Paperwork</b>	Nil
<b>Activity</b>	<p><b>Prior to Match Commencement</b> Familiarise yourself with the scoreboard location and operation. Refer note below regarding electronic Scoreboards.</p> <p><b>During Match</b> After each goal or point, modify the displayed score.</p> <p><b>After Match</b> Leave the scoreboard in an orderly manner Assist in putting equipment away if yours is the last game for the day.</p>
<b>Do's &amp; Don't's</b>	Do endeavor to keep accurate scores at all times. Don't verbalise or comment on any decision made by a Field Umpire. Don't comment to any Player or Spectator.
<b>New Electronic Scoreboard</b>	<p>We are currently arranging to have a new electronic scoreboard installed to our main venue – Gordon Barnard East Oval. <b>When the electronic scoreboard is installed the role of Scoreboard Attendant will be combined with the Time Keepers role.</b></p> <p>The operation of the electronic scoreboard is by the supplied Lap – Top computer. Refer to specific card for operation of the scoreboard. <i>Card and details will be provided when scoreboard is installed and operational.</i></p>
